GAS SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS

Sealed proposals for the work of improving the municipal gas system of the City of Shelby, North Carolina will be received by the City at the City's Utilities Operation Center, 824 W. Grover Street, Shelby, NC 28150, until 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, August 4, 2010. Immediately after this time, the proposals will be publicly opened and read in the Conference Room at the Operations Center.

All work shall be done in accordance with the Plans and Specifications dated May, 2009. The work shall consist of installing one industrial meter set and one distribution regulator station with approximately 280 feet of 6" steel pipe for tie-ins, a two bay steel building with concrete floor and foundation, and approximately 5,300 feet of 4" polyethylene pipe, all as described in the Contract Documents.

Proposals must be submitted on standard forms provided in the Specification booklet and must be marked "Proposal for Gas System Improvements".

Copies may be obtained at the office of Heath and Associates at 108 West Warren Street, P.O. Box 185, Shelby, North Carolina 28150, upon deposit of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each set, which deposit will be refunded upon return of the Plans and Specifications, and other Contract Documents, in good condition, within thirty (30) days after the bid opening date to each bidder who submits a formal proposal to the City. One-half (1/2) the amount of the deposit for all sets of complete documents, including Plans and Specifications, returned in good condition within fifteen (15) days after the opening of bids will be refunded to all prospective bidders who do not submit a formal proposal.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a deposit equal to five (5%) percent of the net price bid. This deposit may consist of cash or a certified check drawn on a bank or trust company authorized to do business in the State of

North Carolina or on a bank insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, payable to the City of Shelby, North Carolina, or a five (5%) percent Bid Bond issued by any insurance company authorized to do business in the State of North Carolina. The deposit is to be retained in the event of failure of the Successful Bidder to execute the contract within (10) days after the award or to give satisfactory surety as required.

All contractors are hereby notified that they shall properly comply with any North Carolina state laws governing their respective trades.

The right is reserved to reject any or all proposals.
