DUMPLIN VALLEY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL EXPANSION PROJECT

Sealed proposals for the work of Dumplin Valley Elementary School Expansion project of the Jefferson Cocke County Utility District will be received by and through the office of the General Manager at 122 Highway 25E, Newport, Tennessee, 37821, until **11:00 o'clock a.m. local time on November 16, 2011.** Immediately after this time the proposals will be publicly opened and read in the Conference Room at the Utility District's office. Contractor crew should be prepared to start January 3, 2012.

All work shall be done in accordance with the Plans and Specifications dated October, 2011. The primary proposal is for work that shall consist of installing 7,330 feet of 6" polyethylene, 700 feet of 2" polyethylene distribution pipe and replace the existing regulator station in Jefferson County as detailed in the proposal.

Proposals must be submitted on standard forms provided in the Specification booklet and must be marked "Dumplin Valley Elementary School Expansion Project".

Box 185, Shelby, North Carolina, 28150, upon deposit of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each set, which deposit will be refunded upon return of the Plans and Specifications, and other Contract Documents, in good condition, within thirty (30) days after the bid opening date to each bidder who submits a formal proposal to the Utility District. One-half (1/2) the amount of the deposit for all sets of complete documents, including Plans and Specifications, returned in good condition within fifteen (15) days after the opening of bids will be refunded to all prospective bidders who do not submit a formal proposal.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a deposit equal to five (5%) percent of the net price bid; this deposit may consist of cash or a certified check drawn on a bank or trust company authorized to do business in the State of Tennessee or on a

bank insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, payable to the Jefferson Cocke County Utility District, Newport, Tennessee or a five (5%) percent Bid Bond issued by any insurance company authorized to do business in the State of Tennessee, the deposit to be retained in the event of failure of the Successful Bidder to execute the contract within ten (10) days after the award or to give satisfactory surety as required.

All contractors are hereby notified that they shall properly comply with any Tennessee state laws governing their respective trades.
